Background Check & Code of Conduct

In a continuing effort to provide a pleasant environment for youth to learn as well as reduce the potential for abuse of children in its programs, the Parks and Recreation Department will continue to enforce the Code of Conduct adopted in 2004 and require background checks for all department employees and volunteer coaches. What division will my child be in?

The aging date that we will use is 7/31/2020. Your child's age on that day will determine his/her division.

Example: If your child's birthday is 8/15/2009, he/she will play in the U10 (under 10) age group. Although they are 10 when the league starts in the spring, they were not 10 on the cut-off date.

All children must be 4 by 1/31/2021!
(12U & 14U are combined into 14U)

Cancellations

Frequently asked Questions

When are the game played?

Games are played on Saturday mornings at 8:30, 10 and 11:30 am at Blackwell Park behind Parkside School.

When will I hear from my child's coach?

The coaches will receive their rosters on February 25 You should receive a call / email from your child's coach by March 5. If you do not hear from them by this time, call Donner Center at (812) 376- 2680.

How long is the season?

There are six games beginning on March 27 and ending May 1.

What about practices?

Teams will be scheduled for 1-2 practices a week. The coach will determine the day / time and contact you with the information.

Can my child change teams if he/she has a schedule conflict?

Unfortunately, no. Due to the size of our soccer program we cannot accommodate everyone. We instead require coaches not to cut a child's playing time simply because they are unable to attend practice.

Does Parks provide uniforms?

Parks and Recreation will give each player a uniform t-shirt. All players must provide their own shin guards and long socks (required). Cleats are optional and are the player's responsibility.

Is there anything my child cannot wear?

Yes!!! Players cannot have beads or hard objects in their hair as well as no jewelry (earrings included).

New piercings cannot be covered with tape.

What if I have a problem?

Go to your coach first. If that does not help, please contact the division manager for your child's age group.
